Lesson 5: The Abrahamic Covenant (Part 1)

Intro: After the flood, Noah's sons turned to paganism (Nimrod), tower of babel

- A. Gen. 6:4-5 the "giants" were large, powerful, alpha-males, warriors.
- B. Gen. 10:6-10 Ham's grandson, Nimrod was a "giant," tower of babel, paganism
- C. Shem's genealogy traced down to Abraham (Gen. 11)

I. Supernatural Redemption Begins:

- A. The call of Abram while in Ur (Gen. 12:1-3; Acts 7:2-8)
 - 1. The initial PROMISE conditioned upon OBEDIENCE
 - a. condition (leave, go), result (I will ...) triggered when Abraham went
 - 2. The aspects of the covenant:
 - a. Gen. 12:1 Multiply his seed to become a great nation (Israel)
 - b. Gen. 12:1 Through Abraham, all nations would be blessed & cursed
 - 1. Matt. 25:31-46 All nations judged by this standard.
 - c. Gen. 15:1-7 A supernatural heir
 - 1. Gen. 16:1-16 Abraham attempts to fulfill God's promise
 - 2. Gen. 17:1 – 18:15 God affirms Sarah will bear Abraham's heir
 - 3. Gen. 21:1-7 Isaac is born miraculously
 - d. Gen. 17:1-8 The promise of being the father of "many nations"
 - e. Gen. 13:14-18 The promise of a permanent Land inheritance
