Module IV – The Life of Christ
Lesson 18 – Jesus’ ‘Going Away’ in John’s Gospel

1. In lesson 17 (Life of Christ) we saw several OT prophecies about Jesus’ “going away,” abandoning Jerusalem to desolation for a period of time:
 - a. Hosea 5-6 until “2 days” 2k years are completed
 - b. Micah 5 “*until she who is in labor has delivered*” (Isa. 66)
 - c. Luke 21 “*until the times of the Gentiles are fulfilled*”
 - d. Psalm 110 ref. in Heb. 10:13 “*waiting until His enemies are made His footstool*”
 - e. Paul in Gal. 4:27 quotes Isaiah 54 where God spoke of divorcing Jerusalem for a time, but eventually taker her back.
2. John’s Gospel (COUNTERING GNOSTICISM) distinguishes Jesus’ origin from that of the rest of mankind.
 - A. John’s Commentary on Jesus’ origin
 1. **John 1:1-5,14,18**
 2. **John 3:13, 31-36**
 - B. Jesus in His own words
 1. **John 6:32-35,38,41-42,48-51,57-58**
 2. On Feast of Tabernacles
 - a. **John 7:33-36**
 - b. **John 8:21-23, 42**
 3. On Passover (night of His betrayal)
 - a. **John 13:31-33**
 - b. **John 14:1-4**
