Module IV – The Life of Christ
Lesson 21 – Judas, Peter, or John?

1. Both Judas and Peter were denounced by Jesus at the supper 2 days before Passover.
 - A. John 13:2,21-30 Judas would betray Jesus
 - B. John 13:31-38 Peter would deny Jesus
2. Both Judas and Peter were denounced by Jesus at the Passover meal
 - A. Luke 22:21-22 Judas partook of communion with Jesus
 - B. Luke 22:31-34 Peter would deny Jesus “this night” (cf. Matt. 26:31-35 & Mark 14:30)
3. Garden of Gethsemane
 - A. Luke 22:39-62 Jesus struggled with the “cup” given Him by the Father
 - B. Heb. 5:5-9 This is when Jesus was “perfected” and became “obedient.”
4. Jesus’ Passover Prayer for the preservation of His followers – John 17
5. Jesus’ arrest
 - A. John 18:12-17 Peter follows but hides out of fear, but John accompanies Jesus before the High Priest who knew him.
6. Examples of Christians facing the end-times:
 - A. Judas an example of those who fall away
 - B. Peter an example of those who are overconfident and ill-prepared
 - C. John an example of those who are fully devoted and prepared
