I. Sundown Day 1: Lamp 1

A. Reading: Genesis 1:26-31 & Genesis 4:25

B. Prayer: *"Blessed are You, O Lord, God of heaven and earth, Who created us in Your image, and allowed us to be called by Your Holy Name, Amen."*

II. Sundown Day 2: Lamps 1-2

A. Reading: Genesis 6:1-14

B. Prayer: *"Blessed are You O Lord, God of heaven and earth, Who spared our father, Noah, when Your judged all the earth with the great flood."*

III. Sundown Day 3. Lamps 1-3

A. Reading: Genesis 12:1-9 & 13:14-18

B. Prayer: *"Blessed are You, O Lord, God of heaven and earth, Who called our father Abraham, and gave him Your everlasting covenant."*

IV. Sundown Day 4. Lamps 1-4

A. Reading: 1 Chronicles 17:1-15 & 2 Chronicles 6:3-11

B. Prayer: *"Blessed are You, O Lord, God of heaven and earth, Who promised David a Son to build your Temple & to reign over the House of Israel forever."*

V. Sundown Day 5. Lamps 1-5

A. Reading: Luke 1:26-38 & Galatians 4:4-7

B. Prayer: *"Blessed are You, O Lord, God of heaven and earth, Who sent Your only-begotten Son to made us your sons & daughters through Him."*

VI. Sundown Day 6. Lamps 1-6

A. Reading: 2 Peter 3:1-13

B. Prayer: *"Blessed are You, O Lord, God of heaven and earth, Who promised us the Kingdom of Your Son, even though He delays a long time."*

VII. Sundown Day 7. Lamps 1-7

A. Reading: Isaiah 35:1-10 & Revelation 20:4-6

B. Prayer: *"Blessed are You, O Lord, God of heaven and earth, Who prepares us to be kings and priests in the Kingdom of Your Son."*

VIII. Sundown Day 8. Lamps 1-8

A. Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:22-28 & Revelation 20:7-10

B. Prayer: *"Blessed are You, O Lord, God of heaven and earth, Who shall judge the world in justice, destroy the wicked, and abolish death forever."*
